# SCOTT FITZGERALD

Francis Scott Key Fitzgerald was born in September 24th, 1896.

He was an American writer, whose works illustrated the Jazz Age and he is now widely regarded as one of the greatest American writers of the 20th.

The Beautiful and Damned, The Great Gatsby,  
and Tender Is the  
Night

A fifth, unfinished novel, The Last Tycoon  
He has 164 short stories in magazines during his  
lifetime.
